The equipment with a modern solution and the procedure used count as an innovation in the production of therapeutic aids.

The system makes the diagnosis of deformations in the foot easier and takes exact measurements of them. Editing the orthosis with the computerised system requires no great expertise and the orthotic insole can be quickly assembled from prefabricated parts.

As many people suffer from painful symptoms caused by deformities of the foot, in our opinion this method of making an orthotic insole will offer fast and efficient help to many people in need.
